## Fee Rates for Crossing Land Border Terminals on January 1, 2024

- The Israel Airports Authority wishes to give notice to the public regarding the fee rates for passengers and cargo crossing the land border terminals in the year 2024.
- Following are the fee rates (in NIS) which will be in effect commencing on January 1, 2024 and until December 31, 2024:

- The fee may be paid by the following methods:
  - At all branches of the Postal Bank in Israel, without an additional commission.
  - At the branches of the financial operator (Milgam Company) at the border terminals, with an additional desk charge of 6 NIS (six New Shekels) per transaction.
  - By credit card on Milgam Company's website: <https://borderpay.metropolinet.co.il/>. This service is not subject to an additional payment for a desk charge.
- The payment at the Postal Bank can be made by cash or bank check only. You do not need to bring a payment voucher with you. The voucher is issued at the Bank branch at the time of the payment.

Also, the fee voucher at the Postal Bank is limited for a payment for only 100 passengers. However, you can make a "multiple receipt", meaning: The payment is made by one bank check, which is divided into a number of payments according to the said limit, up to 100 fees on one voucher, and thereby for a number of vouchers. This means that you can purchase the required number of fees by using one bank check.
