



Public Notice regarding Terminals Operations during the Muslim Festival of Eid al-Adha 2026

1. The Airports Authority hereby notifies that, to mark the Muslim festival of Eid al-Adha, there will be changes in the hours of operation of border terminals, as specified below:
 - 1.1. **Allenby Border Terminal**
 - 1.1.1. **On Wednesday, 27.05.2026, the terminal will be closed to passengers and goods traffic.**
 - 1.1.2. The terminal will reopen as usual on Thursday, 28.05.2026 at 08:00.
 - 1.2. **Jordan River Border Terminal**
 - 1.2.1. The terminal will be open to passengers throughout the Festival:
Sundays to Thursdays, 08:30 to 18:00, passengers will be admitted until 16:30, and on Fridays, 08:30-16:00, passengers will be admitted until 14:30. On Saturdays the terminal is closed to passengers.
 - 1.2.2. **Please note that until 29.05.2026 (inclusive) it will not be possible to leave Israel for Jordan by private vehicle through the border terminal, and the Airports Authority will provide a transportation service from the Israeli side to the Jordanian side, at a cost of NIS 8 per person.**
 - 1.2.3. **The terminal will be closed for goods traffic from Wednesday 27.05.2026 until Thursday 28.05.2026 (inclusive).**
 - 1.3. **Yitzhak Rabin Border Terminal**
 - 1.3.1. The terminal will be open to passengers and goods throughout the Festival during the normal hours of operation.
 - 1.3.2. **Please note that until 29.05.2026 (inclusive) it will not be possible to leave Israel for Jordan by private vehicle through the border terminal.**
 - 1.4. **Menachem Begin Border Terminal**

The terminal will be open to passengers throughout the Festival during the normal hours of operation.
 - 1.5. **Nitzana Border Terminal**

On Tuesday, 26.05.2026, the terminal will be closed to goods traffic.
2. It is emphasized that passengers should arrive at the terminals at least three hours before they close, in order to ensure completion of the proper transit procedures and according to the times specified above.
