Fee Rates for Crossing Land Border Terminals on January 1, 2026

1. The Israel Airports Authority wishes to give notice to the public regarding the fee rates for passengers and cargo crossing the land border terminals in the year 2026.
2. Following are the fee rates (in NIS) which will be in effect commencing on January 1, 2026 and until December 31, 2026:

3. The fee may be paid by the following methods:
 - 3.1. At the branches of the financial operator (Milgam Company) at the border terminals, with an additional desk charge of 7 NIS.
 - 3.2. On Milgam Company's website: <https://borderpay.metropolinet.co.il/>, by credit card without additional payment.
 - 3.3. At all branches of the Postal office in Israel, in accordance with the terms and conditions of Israel Post Ltd. The voucher purchased at the Postal office must be cashed into tolls at Milgam's branch at the terminal.
- Payment at the Postal office can be made in cash or by bank check only, the voucher is issued at the Postal office when the payment is made.
- The voucher at the Postal office is limited to payment for up to 100 passengers only. However, you can make a "multiple receipt", meaning: The payment will be made by a singel bank check, which will be split into several payments according to the limit, up to 100 tolls on one voucher, and thereby for a number of vouchers. This means that you can purchase the required number of tolls by using one bank check.
